With the arrival of the French in 1806 all monasteries for women in Dubrovnik were closed, among them the monastery of St. Klara, the well-known Klarisas, which was turned into a stable and an ammunition warehouse.

Today this monastery has numerous assignments. Its cloister has been a restaurant for decades. It was re-opened in 2011 after complete reconstruction.

Although Fort Imperial, located at the top of the mountain, was taken and destroyed during recent conflicts, it now hosts a museum that provides a glimpse into the destruction that the city endured.

Top of the mountain can be reached by car, walking (about 90 minutes) or the recently reconstructed funicular Two cabins, holding up to 30 passengers, need less than 4 minutes to negotiate the 778 meters distance between the lower and upper stations, passing over one column.

REVELIN FORTRESS



REVELIN FORTRESS

Revelin is a large fortress, an irregular square in a form, built outside the city walls in the eastern part of the city, into the Ploce Gata. It was built in the middle of the 16th century, at the time of the newly-risen Venetian danger threatening the Dubrovnik Republic. The building itself went on rapidly, all other public building-enterprises and most of the private ones were stopped in order to make the unhindered building of the fortress as quick as possible.

ST. LAWRENCE FORTRESS

Rising proudly on a steep cliff about 37 meters high, guardian of the western city gate from land and sea – St. Lawrence Fortress is nowadays one of the most famous stages in the world for performances of Shakespeare's Hamlet. This monumental and impressive fortress so called Gibraltar of Dubrovnik, dating back from the 16th century.

The fort houses a chapel of St. Lawrence, and its courtyard with a cistern serves as a magical venue for gala events. "Non bene pro toto Libertas venditur auro" – Freedom is not to be sold for all the treasures in the world placed above the gate of the two drawbridges that lead to the fort.

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SPONZA PALACE

The Sponza Palace is the most attractive building in Dubrovnik with graceful arcades, intricate tracery on tall gothic windows on the floor above and square windows on the top storey. This was the Republic's custom house and later served as the mint. Sponza Palace now houses precious collections of historical documents of Dubrovnik. Palace is ideal place for the gala dinner. Because its great acustic we suggest for the entertainment a short concert of either male or female a capella group singing local and international songs. Or the group could be welcomed by folklore troupe performing local dance from the region.

RECTOR'S PALACE

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RECTORS PALACE

The Rector's palace was the centre of government in the old Dubrovnik Republic. Mainly built in gothic style this building, simple and harmonic, seems almost too modest for the once so wealthy Dubrovnik. At the first floor the Rector's working and private rooms were situated. Today the Rector's palace is the home to the history department to museum of Dubrovnik. The majority of the halls have styled furniture so as to recreate the original atmosphere of these rooms. In addition to style furniture numerous portraits and coats of arms of the noble families, paintings of old masters, coins minted by the Republic, the original keys of the city gates and the number of important state documents are on permanent exhibit in the palace. The Rector's palace atrium today is one of the most impressive ambient for private events.

Franciscan Monastery was built in the transitional Romanesque-Gothic style. In the museum collection, a part of the cloisters, which housed the ancient Pharmacy, there are Inventories of the Pharmacy (ceramics, bowls, laboratory equipment, and old medical books), as well as works by goldsmiths, embroiderers and painters' studios. Here one can see many incunabula and other valuable books from the Monastery Library, one of the most well known in the world. Of special interest is the painting of Dubrovnik, before the great earthquake of 1667. The Cloister of the Franciscan Monastery is considered to be a masterpiece of architecture in Dubrovnik. It was built in Romanesque-Gothic style by the famous Mihoje Brajkov from Bara. The cloister of the monastery is available for exclusive dinners, cocktails and presentations.



OLD CITY OF DUBROVNIK

The walls of Dubrovnik girdle a perfectly preserved complex of public and private, sacral and secular buildings representing all periods of the City's history, beginning with its founding in the 7th century. Particular mention should be made of the city's main street in the old historical center - Stradun, Rector's Palace, St. Blaise's Church, Cathedral, three large monasteries, Custom's Office and the City Hall. The Republic of Dubrovnik was the centre of a separate political and territorial entity, and was proud of its culture, its achievements in commerce and especially of its freedom, preserved in the course of the stormy centuries.

GUIDED TOUR OF DUBROVNIK WITH VISIT OF THE RAMPARTS



RAMPARTS – THE CITY WALLS

The city ramparts are considered to be one of the most grandiose fortification monuments in Europe, and are an example of how fort architecture developed. The first fortifications were built already in the 8th century, but the most intense construction took place from the mid-15th to the end of the 16th century.

The ramparts encompass the city in an irregularly shaped polygon, with Fort Minčeta at the highest northwestern landward corner of the city and with Fort St. John's on the southeastern seaside.

Strong forts, such as Fort Lawrence at Pile and Fort Revelin at Ploče, are also part of the defence system, even though they are separated from the ramparts.

The ramparts are 22 metres high in places, and from 4 to 6 m. thick on the landward side and from 1-1/2 to 3 m. thick on the seaside. In front of the main wall on the mainland side is an outer wall with 10 semi-circular bastions, in front of which used to be a moat.

There are three entrances to the city ramparts: on Stradun by the Pile gate, by Fort St. John's and at the Custom's House gate..

The goal of the race "Dubrovnik Old Town Challenge" is to find as many given locations as possible, take a photo with the digital camera of these locations and arrive at the finishing point on time. The leader of each team is assigned, and receives a digital camera and a log book. Organizer representatives present the details of the game to the participants. Each photographed location carries certain number of points. Whole team has to be on each photo, except the member who is taking

the actual photo. Every location can be photographed by a different team member and the same location can be photographed several times, but the limit of the camera's memory has to be taken into consideration. The race ends at the agreed time at the finishing point described on one of the cards of log book. The leader of the team reports to the organizer representative and gives digital camera for a review. After 30 minutes the representative proclaim s the winning team and hands out the prizes to the members of the winner team.



LOPUD ISLAND

A small path leads out of Lopud and leads across the island to a miraculous beach in the Bay of Sunj, the Sunj beach.







SUNJ BEACH

This beautiful sandy beach is located on the south side of the island of Lopud and is almost 1km long. The beach is so shallow that you have to walk 100 meters to be able to swim.

There are two restaurants on the beach, sunbeds and umbrellas can be rented.

The beach is in the park forest – you can walk along foot paths and enjoy its beauty. If you want to hide from the sun for a while, there is a beautiful pine tree forest in the back of the Sunj beach, which will welcome you in its shade.

WINE TOUR IN KONAVLE VALLEY

It is always a fun and challenging experience to meet local winemakers and to taste the wines of Konavle. Visitors and guests should not miss the opportunity to taste the quality of the local wines as well as other original products produced in this region.

The program begins with a visit to the vineyard which is part of the Kameni Dvori. Later on the trip continues with a tour around the vineyards and tasting-rooms belonging to the families Vodopic and Brajkovic, wine tasting included. The next stop will be the old mill Sapro, a place where olive oil is being produced in a traditional way and where you can enjoy homemade food. After lunch the adventure continues towards more wine tasting at the home of the Ljubic family in the village Radovcici. More excellent olive oil will be presented to you in the village of Cilipi, and then the Karaman family will explain to you the technique of making outstanding prosecco and dry wine.







TRADITIONAL COOKING

The program starts in the afternoon. The participants are first divided into groups, after which the selection of dishes and the sharing of all tasks are agreed. Every group is under the guidance of a host – the host is the one who will explain about the ingredients and the food preparation process. Please, do not forget that all the dishes will be prepared in a traditional manner, i.e. without electricity and modern kitchen appliance but with the help of a fireplace and water coming from the local well. The evening ends with a big dinner, which is the best opportunity to exchange new experiences and for the handing out of certificates..



VISIT OF WATERMILL DIVANOVIC



WATERMILL DIVANOVIC

There is a system of watermills and stamp mills built on river Ljuta which consisted of eight watermills for flour, two watermills for oil and three stamp mills. System of water mills was built in 16st century and some of them has been preserved until today. Most of the buildings were on the western bank apart from the Divanovic stamp mill, which was on the eastern bank. The mill system was extremely important for the economy of Konavle and the Republic as a whole. The river source and the upper stream is under protection of the Government as a park of nature, whereas the watermill is protected as a cultural monument.

Beautiful nature and restored mill will not leave anyone indifferent. Mill visited by many groups and apart from sightseeing you can taste the local drinks, Konavlian cheese and ham. It is interesting to point out that the waiters and waitresses are dressed in traditional costumes for this region.









PRESENTATION OF THE PRODUCTION OF SILK

PRESENTATION OF THE PRODUCTION OF SILK

Silk production in Konavle region goes back to the 15th century. Silk was exceptionally important fabric here since it was used in weaving Konavle national costume - one of the most beautiful aspects of Croatian cultural heritage. You can see silk worked into Konavle folk dress, most often on decorative bibs and bodices, aprons, caps, waistcoast, suits and elsewhere. This is Konavle's identity and heritage. The art of producing silk was passed among women from generation to generation. Women from Konavle had great respect for the tradition of breeding silk worms and making silk. Perhaps the most interesting thing about silk production is rearing the silkworms themselves. In order to obtain the highest quality threads, man must work in harmony with silk moths, silk worms (in Konavle called bubice") and white mulberry trees on which they feed. The silk threads are teased from the silkworm's cocoon (in Konavle called "puncela") which is made from single thread of raw silk between 300-900 metres long. SOKO FORT

Fort Sokol or Soko Fort is the biggest and for its location on the mountain pass towards Bosnian hinterland, exceptionally important fort from the period of Dubrovnik Republic. It was built on the site of an Illyrian and roman fortification, the proofs for which are the roman details and roman bricks in its walls. It had a cistern, an ammunition dump, a storehouse for wine and food, the accommodation premises for the "castellan", a guard - house and a building for the soldiers. It also had a separate building for the accommodation of woman and children from the nearby villages for the case of war danger. Even today from top of the Fort one has the feeling of respect and admiration for the heritage that the ancient Republic of Dubrovnik has left to us.









FRANCISCAN MONASTERY KONAVLE

The village Pridvorje is situated in the central part of Konavle becomes famous, together with the whole area of Konavle, through Dubrovnik writers in 15th, 16th and 17th century. Following the history of this village we may follow the history of Konavle through two thousand years. In the middle of the village was built the palace which was a pilgrimage place, so it collected a rich treasury of sacral art, where special place belongs to the well-known late gothic wooden crucifixion from Pridvorje.







KONAVLE BEACH

. It is a beautiful hidden beach found below very steep rocks. The only way to access it is by descending down steep steps carved out of the stone (250m altitude). As you descend you have the feeling that something beautiful and magnificent is waiting for you at the bottom because the beach takes your breath away with its raw beauty. The pebbles on the beach are very small and clean, as is the sea at all times throughout the year. Because of its difficulty of access and anchoring, there is rarely a crowd at this beach, which is another advantage.

CAVTAT

Cavtat perches on the saddle of a wooded peninsula set between two bays, so you're never more than moments from the water. The sea is as still as a mirror, a deep and brilliant blue with pools of green reflected from the pine forests beyond. A wide promenade, fringed with palm trees, runs along the harbor front. This is the cosmopolitan centre of the town, where fishing and tourist boats jostle with gleaming jet-set yachts the size of battleships Cavtat is about light. In the daytime, the town shimmers. In the evening, clouds in the night sky are outlined in a glow of copper and silver, looking for all the world like strange new countries on a mysterious old map. It's no wonder that the place has attracted so many artists.

Green island of Mljet, situated in the southern part of the Adriatic sea, is well known for its rich cultural and natural heritage, dense Mediterranean vegetation and transparent and clear sea with great variety of sea life.

Since the medieval ages, island has been well known for it's exceptional products: goat cheese and vine.

Today, many lovers of the authentic nature discover this island in their escape from the urban life.

Mljet is 35 km long, and inhabited with less than 1000 souls who live in the 15 villages completely in harmony with nature. Their main occupations are fishing, agriculture and tourism. Settlements are connected with a road which extends from the National Park in the northwestern part to the Saplunara bay at the southeastern most part of the island.

VISIT OF STON AND OYSTER FARM

Ston is a small town in the Dubrovnik area, located at the south of of the peninsula Peljesac. The distance of Ston from Dubrovnik is only 59 kilometres (37 miles).

The whole Peljesac peninsula has about 2500 dwellers whereas 600 inhabitants are living only in Ston. Ston was a military fort of the Ragusan Republic whose defensive walls are among the most famous in the world: there is a 900 meters (3000 feet) long town wall and 5 km (3 miles) Great Wall outside the town. The walls extend to Mali Ston (Little or Small Ston), a smaller town on the northern side of the Peljesac isthmus and the end of the Mali Ston bay. It is noteworthy to mention that Ston walls are the second longest defensive walls in the world, second only to the Great Chinese wall.

ISLAND KORCULA

The central-Dalmatian island of Korcula stretches parallel with the nearby mainland, the Peljesac Channel, which separates it from Peljesac peninsula, is 1,270 m wide at its narrowest point. Like most of the Croatian islands, the Greeks, who gave it the name Korkyra Melaina or 'Black Corfu' for its dark and densely wooded appearance, first settled Korcula, in the 6th century before Christ, at first next to today's Vela Luka.

Today, the island of Korcula represents a unique fusion of beautiful nature, thousands of years of cultural tradition and history, and modern tourism. Numerous beautiful beaches and bays, luxurious hotels and summer houses, centuries old olive groves and vineyards, and ancient towns and villages on the island which seem as if they have remained lost in some long past time attract tourist from all over the world to this island.







KORCULA TOWN

The historical centre of the island is built on a small peninsula which narrows the passage between the island and the mainland to a bare 1270 meters. The obvious possibility of controlling the navigation of galleys and sailing ships along the eastern coast of the Adriatic at this location was the reason for the foundation of a small town-fortress, to render this important service to various masters The town is at the peak of its might in the 16th century when it could receive 6000 inhabitants. Building is fairly concentrated; the whole city enclosed by walls does not surpass by in its surface one modern football stadium; some experts compare medieval Korcula and its narrow streets with Manhattan. The town impressed many medieval writers and travel writers, through its fortifications, many invaders

RESTAURANT RADOBOLJA

The Restaurant Radobolja is situated in the city centre of Mostar, Although in the very centre, the restaurant is sheltered from the swarming streets by the plane-tree alley. It was built 10 years ago inside the orchard and on the river Radobolja. It is a combination of traditional and modern-style restaurant.

Apart from the traditional cuisine, the menu of the restaurant offers ordered meals and as a house specialty home-made bread and dishes made under the baking lid. The restaurant indoors is with the capacity of 120 seats, outdoors 300 out of which 100 seats are roofed over.







ARCHEOLOGICAL MUSEUM NARONA

Archeological museum Narona is situated in the village of Vid, some 3 kilometres west from the nearest town of Metkovic and app. 20 km from the Adriatic Sea coastline. This is the first museum in Croatia built on the archeological locality "in situ". It was built over ruins of Augustus temple in former Roman town Narona (probably destroyed in 7th century), thus the name.

Archeological museum Narona protected and preserved unique and world findings whose presentation enables the most representative complex of antique town Narona to be experienced.







DELTA OF THE NERETVA RIVER

The delta of the Neretva River one of the best preserved wetlands of Europe. As an untouched natural environment offering shelter for numerous birds, fish and other species.

We will embark the ancient wooden boats, locally known as "trupice", and sail through the magnificent marshland. It is really a special feeling when driving through this jewel of nature in the old local boats. We will also visit the remains and excavations of one of the largest Roman sites on the eastern side of the Adriatic called Narona. We can also organize a photo safari.







DJUDJA & MATE

At Restaurant Djudja & Mate, the flavors of the Neretva river delta reign supreme, from skewer roasted river eel to wild coot prepared in the hunter's style. And then there is the crowning glory of Neretva cuisine, the regional brudet of eels and whole frogs in spicy paprika broth, served with fat dumplings of polenta and plenty of fresh bread to soak up the juices.

Hearty and satisfying, neretvanski brudet is the sort of wild cuisine you could expect to find in the Louisiana bayou, only without the swampy aftertaste. The meat of the eels and frogs from this area is rich, yet as fresh and clean tasting as you'd expect from such clear waters.







BIKING TOUR IN KONAVLE VALLEY

The tour starts from the village of Gruda in Konavle area known for its beautiful landscapes with large valley surrounded by mountains dotted with charming villages. We bike along the fields, orchards and vineyards, passing across a small bridge over the Ljuta and Konavočica rivers. Occasional short breaks are made to introduces you into the history and traditions of the Konavle area passed down through generations. Visit to the Franciscan Monastery in Pridvorje and old watermills by the river Ljuta. During the breaks refreshments with fruit and water is available. Taking small village roads, we return to Gruda for wine tasting of local wines.
