
1. Test, test, test

a) to find as many new cases as possible, identify and break chains of contagion

- b) to treat everyone (locals and visitors)
- c) to plan the response of the national health service

We are one of the countries that does more tests (in % of population)

- \checkmark +1.1 million tests, 10% of the population already tested
- ✓ ranked **6**th in Europe
- ✓ only 3.67% of positive results



"Those who test, find" Portugal has complied with international health authorities advice and has an objective: testing to find, act responsibly and Increase knowledge of group immunity, essential to contain a second wave of the outbreak.




2. Apply measures when and where necessary the ENTIRE COUNTRY, thanks to a responsible attitude from all, has the Virus under control. Although, some areas within the periphery of the metropolitan region of Lisbon have seen an increase in the rate of infections; therefore, some restrictions are in effect **EXCLUSIVELY** for the metropolitan area of Lisbon:

- shops close at 20:00
- meetings are limited to 10 people
- alcoholic beverages cannot be sold in petrol stations, service areas, or in public outdoor spaces
- all remaining facilities are 100% operational (shops, restaurants, museums, etc)

There are no restrictions to freedom of movement or trade in any other area

> LISBON 77% of new cases are concentrated in the greater Lisbon are GREATER AND only in a few neighbouring areas, all residential NONE touristic

3. TRANSPARENCY – provide CLEAR information Health Authorities share daily information about the evolution of the pandemic and appeals for everyone's committed and responsible behaviour

- > Occupancy rate for intensive care in hospitals is below critical and far from full capacity
- > National Health Service will treat and care everyone (nationals and visitors alike)
- > Current figures have decreased.



4. RESTART of economic activity complying with safety rules and protocols that allow companies to operate, and citizens and tourists access to goods and services






INFECTION DATA

May 4

Open

- •Shops < 200 sqm
- Hairdressers
- •Libraries, book shops
- Individual sports (paddle tennis, golf, tennis)
- Public services

May 18 Open

• Shops < 400 sqm

Phase 2

- Restaurants, cafés, terraces up to 50% of capacity and closing at 23:00
- Museums, Palaces
- Schools
- Kindergartens
- Religious services

Phase 3

June 1

Open

- Shopping Centres / Shops > 400 sqm
- Shops & Restaurants: 100% capacity keeping social distance of 1.5m
- Cinemas, venues, theatres with limited capacity
- Outdoor Sports (no spectators)
- Collective Sports
- Gyms and Swimming pools

June 15

Open

 Shopping Centres / Shops
> 400sqm in Lisbon

Phase 4

- Aqua Parks
- Water Sports





OPEN AIR SPACE

Airspace to and from Portugal is <u>OPEN</u> to all flights from:

Schengen Area (+ Liechtenstein, Norway, Iceland and Switzerland); Brazil (S. Paulo and Rio Janeiro); UK; USA; Canada; Venezuela; South Africa; European Union nationals, nationals of States associated with the Schengen Area and third-country nationals legally resident in a Member State of the European Union; Third-country nationals traveling for study purposes.

End of airspace restrictions to countries outside the EU: 30 June 2020
