When we continue on our way it is only about a 90 min drive to the hotel where we will check-in and freshen up.

Our guide will as well talk about the water and get guests interested in using the bottles




When arriving close to the lava, why not have a private drink to start the adventure in the land of ice and fire.

As this is Iceland we can offer a tent if the group needs to have an option to go inside.




## **Hotel Geysir\*\*\*\***

The hotel was designed to harmoniously blend the building with the surrounding environment through the use of materials that reflect the surroundings and the architectural design of the building. The hotel's rooms and suites are bright and light and all have views of the stunning scenery.

There are large windows throughout the hotel so you can admire the landscape including the magnificent Geysir and hot spring area while passing through. The dining rooms are on the first and second floor and can open up into the hotel's garden.

The area is famous for the geothermal hot springs and geysers which the hotel is in perfect close proximity to and can be seen in awe during the day and night. If you are lucky enough, at night you will witness the bubbling hot springs contrasting with the Northern Lights (September to March).

Having the glaciers makes snowmobiling an ideal sport in Iceland and something we do on a regular basis but it is best from September to June - while the white tundra is still fluffy and fun.

The guides will take you on a snowmobile adventure in the Icelandic highlands, giving you the most amazing views of the majestic glacier and its unique surroundings




## DAY 3 THE CAPITAL OF THE NORTH

When we return to Reykjavík we can have free time until dinner, and we can pick between dinner in a fun Reykjavík location




# Laugarvatn Fontana Geothermal Baths

Laugarvatn Fontana Geothermal Baths are located in the center of the Golden Circle. A unique experience of the healing powers of the geothermal springs. Soak in a natural pool, listen to the bubbling hot spring in the steam rooms, or for the venturesome, take a dip in the refreshing lake.

Since 1929, locals have been enjoying the healing powers of the natural steam baths by Lake Laugarvatn. Hot, healing steam simmers directly from the ground through grids in the cabin floors of the three traditional steam rooms.

Completing the ensemble is the lake itself and the beach. Bathers can walk into the cool lake from a pier or walk on the warm black sand beach. A cool dip in between the hot steam rooms and sauna is a refreshing temperature shift for the healthy heart.

## **Lava Tunnel**

A journey into Raufarhólshellir is a unique experience and a great opportunity to witness the inner workings of a volcanic eruption as one walks in the path of lava that flowed during the Leitahraun eruption, which occurred east of the Bláfjöll mountains about 5200 years ago.

helmets and lights provided.

Warm clothes and sturdy shoes are recommended, usually, some water dripping from the ceiling so wearing water-resistant is recommended Total duration: 1 hour, 1,5 hours on location

## HORSE BACK RIDING




## Aurora Base camp
